

EFM will replace FISLink in June 2025

Beginning June 15, 2025, the ability to share files through FISLink will be removed. FISLink's replacement, Enterprise File Mover (EFM), is now available. EFM leverages two distinct environments within the U.S. and Europe, instead of the four previously used environments with FISLink.



Important notes regarding this replacement project:

- Client user accounts and data in FISLink environments are not being migrated as part of this transition.
- Clients must be invited to use the system. A new message sent by an FIS employee from EFM will
  create accounts for clients/customers.
- A starter password and the URL for EFM will be sent via email when a new account is created.
- The EFM Client user guide is available <a href="here">here</a>. This shows the login process and how to use the system.
- Multi-factor authentication is required for EFM accounts. MFA setup will be required during the first login.
- Files sent through FISLink will be available until the normal file expiration date, 14 or 30 days, depending on the specific FISLink environment.

## **Important dates:**

June 15, 2025: Access to send files via FISLink will be removed. All secure file transfers must be transitioned to EFM by this date.

July 15, 2025: FIS employees and clients can no longer sign in to FISLink.
